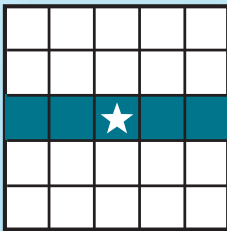


# How does TEEN BOOK BINGO WORK?

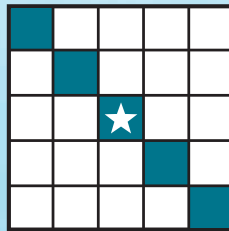

## HOW DO I PLAY?

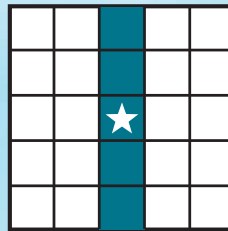

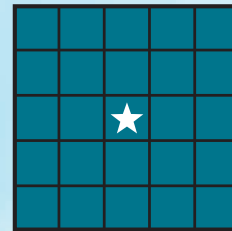
Row Example
